

**ROOM IN THE INN  
ST. IGNATIUS**

The congregation of St. Ignatius has helped in sheltering the homeless on Friday nights for the past **twenty-two years**. We usually house fourteen guests including men, women, and children. This year the program will begin on the first Friday in November and continues through the last Friday in March.

Please read the following descriptions of the various jobs that need to be filled for each evening and check the one or more that you would be interested in.

\_\_\_\_\_ **INNKEEPERS:** As an innkeeper you are asked to be at the church by 6:30pm. Our guests arrive at 7pm. You would be helping in the activities of the evening as well as the morning. Included in these activities are: helping with the dinner, talking with the guests, serving the breakfast, and helping to ready the downstairs for PRE on Sunday (usually takes about 30 minutes after our guests leave.)

**MEALS**

\_\_\_\_\_ **DINNER:** Friday evening we try to have a balanced meal for our guests. Many times several people will team and provide different parts of the meal. We ask that these items be delivered to the church by 6:30 pm in order to be able to serve our guests as soon as they arrive.

\_\_\_\_\_ **LUNCH:** We try to supply our guests with sack lunches to take with them. In the past years these have been prepared both at home and at the church. (Sandwich meat, bread, condiments, chips, cookies, fruit, and a canned drink.)

\_\_\_\_\_ **BREAKFAST:** The breakfast can be either hot or cold. Some previous successes have included sausage casseroles, ham and biscuits, and cereal and donuts. With all breakfasts please include juice and milk. This is usually brought to the church on Friday evening, but there have been some volunteers who have elected to come in the morning to cook.

\_\_\_\_\_ **CLOTHING:** Volunteers are needed to help sort and straighten the clothing each week. The clothing room is located downstairs behind the boiler room.

\_\_\_\_\_ **LAUNDRY:** The linen used on Friday nights is laundered sometime during the week to be readied for the next weekend. A washer and dryer are located in the basement for this purpose.
